Repertoire: Students should prepare a movement from a standard concerto or work that has an orchestral accompaniment. The selected work should be less than 10 minutes in length. The winner will perform the work with the Anchorage Civic Orchestra (ACO). Orchestral parts must be readily available and a reasonable cost. Please consult with your private teacher about the appropriateness of your piece.
Performance: The ACO Concerto Competition Winner will perform at the ACO Family Concert on March 10, 2012. To prepare for this performance, the winner agrees to participate in regular ACO rehearsals on specific Tuesday evenings as determined by the ACO Music Director and to attend the ACO Dress Rehearsal for the concert.
Award: After the performance, the Competition Winner will be presented with a \$200 prize donated by the Music Man.

Anchorage Civic Orchestra Concerto Competition

High School-Age Band and Orchestra Players

Eligibility

The competition is open to Anchorage area high school-aged musicians who play a woodwind, brass, string or percussion instrument. Past winners are not eligible.

Repertoire

Students should prepare a movement from a standard concerto or a work that has an orchestral accompaniment, with the intent of performing with the Anchorage Civic Orchestra (ACO). The selected work should be less than 10 minutes in length.

Awards

Winner receives (1) a solo performance opportunity with the Anchorage Civic Orchestra and (2) a \$200 prize donated by the Music Man. Honorable Mention prizes may also be awarded at the discretion of the judges.

The ACO Concerto Competition Winner will perform with the Orchestra at the Family Concert on March 10, 2012.
